

**Resurrection Bay Cruise with Fox Island
Seward, Alaska**

Depart Anchorage for a relaxing 2½-hour ride to Seward on Alaska's only National Scenic Byway watching for eagles, Dall sheep and moose along the way. Or travel aboard the historic Alaskan Railroad on a 4½-hour train ride to Seward. Once in Seward you will embark on this unique cruise designed for people to view both the awesome migratory and the year round resident whales of the Resurrection Bay area. Often the Orca whales and the Dall porpoise come up and play off the wake of the boat, so don't miss this wonderful photo opportunity. Even if the whales prove elusive, you still have many opportunities to view various marine wildlife including sea otters, eagles and sea lions. You'll also stop over at Fox Island where a freshly grilled salmon lunch with all the trimmings is prepared for you at the beautiful day lodge.

Tour Includes: 5-Hour Narrated Cruise, Salmon Bake Lunch at Fox Island and Logistics Staff Coordination.

Daily Cruise Departure: Departs Seward Dock at 12:00PM and Returns to the Dock at 5:00PM.

Via Railroad: Check in at the Alaska Railroad Depot at 6:15AM. Departs Anchorage at 6:45AM and Returns to Anchorage at 10:25PM. Transportation To and From the Rail Depot Is On Your Own.

**Kenai Fjord National Park Cruise
Seward, Alaska**

Depart Anchorage for a 2½-hour drive on Alaska's only National Scenic Byway watching for eagles, Dall sheep and moose along the way. Or travel aboard the historic Alaskan Railroad for a 4½-hour train ride to Seward. Once there you'll embark for a magnificent day of cruising the spectacular fjords of Resurrection Bay and Kenai Fjords National Park. This wildlife and glacier cruise takes you through Resurrection Bay, around Aialik Cape; to the very face of an active tidewater glacier where you'll spend time watching glaciers calve giant splinters of blue ice into the ocean. Visit the Chiswell Islands, part of the Alaska Maritime National Wildlife Refuge, where thousands of colorful seabirds nest, and a small island where over 20,000 horned and tufted puffins make their nests every summer. Look for graceful humpback whales, Orcas, playful otters and hear Stellar sea lions bellow from rocky cliffs.

Tour Includes: 6-Hour Narrated Wildlife & Glacier Cruise, Lunch and Logistics Staff Coordination.

Daily Cruise Departure: Cruise Departs Seward at 11:30AM and Returns to Dock at 5:30PM.

Transportation Schedule

Via Van: Departs Anchorage at approximately 7:00AM from the Egan Convention Center (downtown) and Returns to Anchorage at approximately 10:00PM. Pick-Up and Drop Off Will Vary Depending On Which Hotel You're Staying at.

**26 Glacier Cruise
Whittier, Alaska**

Depart Anchorage for a 1-hour and 15-minute drive to Whittier on Alaska's only National Scenic Byway watching for eagles, Dall sheep and moose along the way. Or board the historic Alaska Railroad for a 2½-hour scenic train ride to Whittier. You'll pass through Portage, where the 1964 earthquake caused the land to drop between 6 and 12 feet along the Turnagain Arm. High tides then flooded the area, forcing the estimated 50 to 100 residents of Portage to move. Rustic old buildings and "Ghost Forests" are visible signs of remains by the invading saltwater. Then you'll continue on through two mountain tunnels to Whittier. Arriving at the Port of Whittier passengers will board the Klondike Express for a day of spectacular scenery. This cruise will travel over 110 miles in glacier filled Prince William Sound. You'll visit College Fjord, Barry Arm and Harriman Fjord. Get within 400 feet of the towering walls of ice called Tidewater glaciers and also view Alpine or Hanging and Piedmont glaciers. Sea otters, seals, porpoises and whales make these waters their home, and bird watchers will find this trip a one-of-a-kind.

Tour Includes: 4½-Hour Narrated Cruise, Lunch and Logistics Staff Coordination.

Daily Cruise Departure: Departs Whittier at 1:00PM and Returns to Dock at 5:30PM.

Transportation Schedule

Via Motorcoach: Check in at the Captain Cook Hotel at 10:45AM. Departs Hotel at 11:00AM and Returns to Hotel at 7:15PM.

Via Railroad: Check in at the Alaska Railroad Depot at 9:30AM. Departs Anchorage at 10:00AM and Returns to Anchorage at 9:45PM. Transportation To and From the Rail Depot Is On Your Own.
