

Halibut Fishing Charter Seward, Alaska

Depart Anchorage for a 2½-hour drive to Seward where the ultimate deep-sea fishing experience awaits you! Not only will you be fishing the most productive halibut grounds in the world but also you'll be fishing with the company that pioneered these waters. Get ready for the fight of a lifetime...these giant Pacific Halibut have been known to exceed well over 500 pounds! No expense has been spared to ensure that each person experiences the finest boat, equipment, and expertise at their disposal. Each angler is permitted to keep 2 halibut per day.

Tour Includes: 8 to 10-Hour Guided Halibut Fishing, Bait, Tackle, Fishing Equipment, Filleting, Cleaning and Logistics Staff Coordination.

Daily Departure From Seward: Departs Seward Dock at 6:30AM and Returns to Seward Dock between 5:00-6:00PM.

Note: Transfers are on your own. To request a rental car please fill out information on registration form. Children must be 10 years of age or older. Fishing licenses are \$10.00 per person per day and can be purchased at the office in Seward before departing. Please remember your drivers' license to purchase your fishing license. It is a very long day on the boat so don't forget to bring lunch, snacks and refreshments. There are no gratuities included.



Fishing on the Kenai Sterling, Alaska

You will depart Anchorage for a 2½-hour drive to Sterling traveling along the breathtaking Turnagain Arm, famous for its unusual bore tide. This drive has been voted one of the Top Ten Most Scenic Drives in America by Conde Nast Magazine. Once past Turnagain Arm enjoy following the Seward and Sterling Highway, which winds through a land of remarkable beauty of knife-edged ridges and alpine valleys. The diversity of landscape and wildlife is the hallmark of this highway corridor. Be sure to watch for eagles, Dall sheep and moose during your trip to Sterling. You will also get a chance to see the famous Kenai Lake. Be sure to include enough time to stop and take pictures at one of the many rest stops along the way. Once in Sterling you will enjoy a delicious Salmon Baked lunch prepared by an excellent chef. After lunch your day will be spent on the famous Kenai River enjoying a guided salmon fishing trip with all equipment provided.

Option # 1 – With Transportation

Tour Includes: Round Trip Transportation, 5-Hours of Guided Fishing, Fishing License, Fishing Gear, Fish Cleaning, Salmon Bake Lunch and Logistics Staff Coordination.

Daily Departure From Anchorage: Departs Hilton Anchorage at 7:30AM and Returns to Hilton Anchorage at 9:00PM.

Option # 2 – Without Transportation

Tour Includes: 5-Hours of Guided Fishing, Fishing License, Fishing Gear, Fish Cleaning and Logistics Staff Coordination.

Daily Departure From Sterling: Check in at the Great Alaska Adventure Lodge in Sterling, Alaska at 11:30am. You will then drive to fishing departure point in Soldotna, Alaska (12 miles). The fishing tour departs at 12:00PM and returns at 6:00PM.

Note: Please remember your drivers' license in order to get your fishing license. You may drive yourself to Sterling. To request a rental car please fill out the information on the registration form. The Salmon Bake Lunch is not included when you drive on your own.

Full Day Fly-In Fishing

Experience some of the world's best fishing in Alaska's backcountry, only minutes away from Anchorage by floatplane. You will enjoy a narrated flightseeing trip to and from your fishing destination. Once you're in Alaska's backcountry you will enjoy a guided fishing trip with an experienced Alaskan guide and all equipment provided. From fighting salmon, to landing that rainbow trout, you'll be flown to a remote lake or stream to where the action is and the crowds aren't!

Tour Includes: Transfers, 1½-Hour Floatplane Sightseeing Tour, 6-7 Hours Guided Fishing, Fishing Gear, Fishing License, Fish Cleaning, Box Lunch With Refreshments and Logistics Staff Coordination. **Tour Operates Dependent on Weather.**

Daily Departure From Anchorage: Departs at 7:30AM and Returns at 7:00PM.

Notes: Pick up and drop off times vary, depending on which hotel you are staying at. Please remember your drivers' license in order to get your fishing license. Trout is catch and release only. If you are fishing for King Salmon there will be an additional \$10.00 charge for the King Salmon stamp.
