2-Day/2-Night Cordova Adventure

Enjoy a fun filled 3-day/2-night adventure at Orca Adventure Lodge. This remote lodge is located two miles north of Cordova, Alaska on the eastern shores of Prince William Sound. Cordova is often referred to as "Alaska's Hidden Treasure". Surrounded by glacier-carved mountains, it lies in the northern boundary of the farthest north temperate rainforest in the United States. Orca Adventure Lodge is Alaska's most unique adventure destination; this recently restored cannery town is the ideal base for exploring Alaska's Gulf Coast. You will enjoy many of Alaska's best attractions and opportunities here. From watching Sea otters play out your front window, glacier hiking, fly-out wilderness adventures to world-class fishing, this is the place to do it all! You will begin your adventure with a 40-minute flight from Anchorage to Cordova, flying over some of Alaska's magnificent mountain ranges and body's of water. Once you have landed in Cordova you will be completely taken care of from the minute you step off the plane. A guide will be there to greet you and transfer you to the lodge. Along the way your guide will familiarize you with the local area and history of Cordova. You will get a chance to stop along the way to take pictures of any wildlife you might see. The next day you will have a chance to view the famous Child's glacier and the Million Dollar Bridge. You'll marvel at the 350-foot high glacier as you stand on the shores of the Copper River. Watch it send huge chunks of ice calving into the river with a thunderous roar! To top off your day of glacier exploring, you will have the opportunity to take a raft tour paddling among the icebergs. Afterwards you will get to step onto the glacier for a short hike. You also enjoy having a free day to explore on your own or take a guided or unguided sea kayaking trip, hiking excursion or a trip into town.

Anchorage City Trolley Tour

Enjoy a lively informative 1-hour sightseeing tour of Alaska's largest city. Relax while your Alaskan guide shows you how and where Alaskans live. Take a glance of the Alaska Railroad Depot and the Ship Creek area. It's fun to take a quick look to see if the salmon are running up the fish ladders and to watch the locals try to catch a returning salmon. They're often more entertaining than the fish! You will also get to see Lake Hood, which is the largest and busiest floatplane base in the world. Lake Hood is a great place to relax and watch the many landings and takeoffs of floatplanes, which range in size from small two-seaters to many passenger, twin-engine Otters. During a peak summer day, more than 800 float plane landings and takeoffs are accommodated. You will make a stop at Earthquake Park. When the "Good Friday" earthquake rocked Anchorage in March of 1964, the area that is now the park was an affluent residential area on the bluffs above Cook Inlet. The 9.2 earthquake dropped these homes into 30-foot crevasses and destroyed this entire area. Developed as a park years later, it carries monuments and reader boards with information on the great quake. This is a great opportunity to take a good look at Cook Inlet. The Inlet is has the second largest tides in the World. The Trolley tour also gives you a classic view of the whole downtown Anchorage area. While enjoying the trolley ride make sure to notice Anchorage's famous flowers and great shopping areas!
