

### Kenai Princess Lodge/Carriage Ride Adventure Getaway

You will depart Anchorage in a rental car for a 2-hour drive traveling along the breathtaking Turnagain Arm; famous for its unusual bore tide. This drive has been voted one of the Top Ten Most Scenic Drives in America by Conde Nast Magazine. Be sure to watch for eagles, Dall sheep and moose during your trip to Cooper Landing. Be sure to include enough time to stop and take pictures at one of the many rest stops along the way. Once in Copper Landing, check in at the Kenai Princess Lodge. This lodge is the gem of the Kenai Peninsula. Nestled within the Chugach National Forest and the Kenai Wildlife Refuge, this Lodge is a true Alaskan getaway, overlooking the stunning turquoise Kenai River. After settling into your cabin, prepare for a carriage ride through the backcountry of Cooper Landing. Great photo opportunities are in abundance throughout the area. Many say this ride is the best memory of their Alaskan vacation! After your ride enjoy a soak in one of the many hot tubs available, and before bed relax next to your own personal fireplace in your cabin.

### Exploring the Alaska Native Heritage Center

Upon your arrival at the Native Heritage Center, step into the “Welcoming House” and find yourself immersed in the culture of Alaska’s First People. Interpretive exhibits, dance performances, films and galleries give you a glimpse into the life and times of native groups from the Athabaskan and Inupiaq tribes to the Tlingit, Haida and Tsimshian Peoples. Just minutes from downtown Anchorage, the 26-acre Heritage Center is nestled on a lake and provides a walking trail through the recreated villages of five different native cultures, introducing you to their traditional crafts and lifestyle. Meeting Native Tradition Bearers, artists and performers, touring the five historic village exhibits, enjoying dance performances, demonstrations and indoor and outdoor exhibits, viewing the special film presentation, or simply delighting in the beautiful natural setting makes a visit to the Center an unforgettable experience!

**Tour Includes:** Admission Fee to the Alaska Native Heritage Center and Logistics Staff Coordination.

**Daily Departures From Anchorage:** The center is open from 9am-6pm daily.

**Note:** The Alaska Native Heritage Center will be providing a free shuttle from different points in downtown Anchorage. The times will be included with your confirmation voucher.



### 4-Wheeling Bird Creek, Alaska

Depart Anchorage for a 30-minute drive to Bird Creek where your adventure will begin kicking up some dust along the Bird Creek Trail. Your guided 4-wheeler excursion will take you through a maze of trails winding through temperate rainforest. Your group will be able to choose between two trails. One trail will take you across the Penguin River up more than 2,000 feet to the high alpine meadows of Hidden Valley. The other trail takes you to an area referred to as the Sanctuary. You’ll take a short hike down to a Clearwater pool with spawning salmon and a spectacular waterfall. Keep your eyes open; wildlife is prevalent along this trail. You’ll have so much fun with these tours that you’ll want to do it again!

**Tour Includes:** 4-Hour Guided 4-Wheeler Tour, Helmets, Rain Gear, Refreshments, Snacks and Logistics Staff Coordination. **There is a 3 Person Minimum Requirement to Operate This Tour.**

**Daily Departure From Bird Creek:** Departs at 2:30PM and Returns at 6:30PM.

**Note:** You must be 16 years or older to take this tour. Transfers are available at an additional cost.
