Talkeetna River 2 Hour Float

Few places in the world can equal the scale and beauty of Mt. McKinley and the Alaska Range. You will explore nine miles of the lower end of the famous Talkeetna River. Your journey will begin with a narrated ride through the historic townsite of Talkeetna. On the way to the boat launch, you will stop and visit a typical Alaskan homestead with sled dog racing kennel. There is a chance to see bears, eagles, fish, beavers, moose, fox and waterfowl during your scenic float on the Talkeetna River.

Tour Includes: Round Trip Transfers, 2-Hour Narrated Scenic Float Tour, and Logistics Staff Coordination. **There is a Minimum Requirement of 2 Persons to Operate This Tour. Tour Ends Operation September 16, 2005.**

Chulitna River 4 Hour Float

You will find yourself rafting through the pristine wildlands of Denali State Park (and the borderlands of Denali National Park). From the launch at mile 133 of the Glen Parks Highway, this trip proceeds nineteen miles down the glacial-fed Chulitna to return you to Talkeetna. Throughout the float, a stunning view of Mt. McKinley and the entire Alaska Range provides a spectacular backdrop. This remote portion of the Chulitna River is prime bald eagle, bear, salmon and moose habitat. You will take a break at an authentic gold-panning site for a cup of hot cocoa or coffee and chocolate chip cookies from the Talkeetna Roadhouse.

Tour Includes: Round Trip Transfers, 4-Hour Narrated Scenic Float Tour, Refreshments, Snacks, and Logistics Staff Coordination. **There is a Minimum Requirement of 2 Persons to Operate This Tour. Tour Ends Operation September 16, 2005.**

Option #10

Dog Mushing with Sundog Kennel

Your tour begins at the little log office in downtown Talkeetna with Sundog Racing Kennel, with a short narrated bus trip, describing the history of Talkeetna and sled dog racing. You will visit an authentic Alaskan log cabin, watch a brief video on the Iditarod Trail Sled Dog Race, meet the dogs and see a demonstration of sled harnessing and mushing preparation. Learn about the winter training program and what it takes to get these dogs ready for the Iditarod Trail Sled Dog Race. Then go for a 4-mile run on the dirt and tree lined trails of Talkeetna. After your ride, you then return to the kennels for some "puppy time" where you can hold and take photos of the newest additions to the Sundog Kennel racing team!
