In the election of officers the following members were unanimously elected:

J. L. Hart - Canada - President  
James C. Simpson, Idaho - Vice President  
Fred A. Thompson, New Mexico - Secretary &  
Treasurer

In addition to this as a suggestion to the Parent Society, Clarence Pautzke, Washington, was elected as a member to the International Relations and A. F. C. Greene of Wyoming as a member of the State International Relations Committee.

The constitution and by-laws for the Western Division was presented but after considerable discussion the Committee agreed to take its recommendation into hand again for redrafting and present it at the next annual meeting of the Western Division. The following resolutions were presented and passed unanimously:

- (1) That fisheries information be more thoroughly disseminated among the fisheries workers throughout the country.
- (2) Encouraging early passage of the Johnson - Dingell Bill now in the Congress of the United States.
- (3) Appreciation to the Parent Association for their consideration in the establishment of a Western Division.
- (4) Appreciation to the State of Washington for their hospitality and cooperation in handling the Western Division meetings.

After all the old business had been transacted, James Simpson was escorted to the chair in behalf of J. L. Hart and after calling for any additional business the meeting was adjourned.
